


SAFETY

Safety

Safety is a core value at John Burns Construction Company. At JBCC we believe that Safety is everyone's responsibility and every employee regardless of their job title plays a role in completing a project incident free. This commitment to safety was reflected by the over 2,500 hours of Safety training completed by both the JBCC field crews and Project Managers during the first half of 2019. This training was centered around the hazards that our employees see on the job site every day. Topics covered this year included safe excavation best practices, electrical safety, confined space entry, fall protection, defensive driving and work zone safety. In February of 2019 JBCC transitioned to electronic Safety Management Software. JBCC field crews can now access all company safety policies and best practices on their iPad in the field. Additionally, our field crews now complete Daily Job Hazard Analysis, Toolbox Talks, Near Miss and Incident Reports electronically via their iPads as well. This advance in technology has helped the company track trends and leading indicators in real time and address these hazards before an incident occurs.

Quality

Quality has always been part of the JBCC mission statement. In 2019 JBCC hired a full time Quality Manager to lead this part of the company. This year JBCC will begin revising our current Quality Program to ensure compliance with industry best practices and best in class companies. Similar to Safety, it takes a total team effort to build a Quality project that exceeds customer expectations. Defining roles in the Quality process and continuous training and auditing of those expectations are some of the first objectives of the new Quality Department.






CIT CHICAGO SMART LIGHTING PROJECT







John Burns Construction will be performing the Targeted Infrastructure Stabilization Repairs which will increase the reliability of the existing lighting infrastructure and extend its useful life to at least as long as the new LED fixtures. These infrastructure repairs will improve safety, increase reliability, increase light pole structural stability, reduce failure rates, and extend the useful life of existing lighting infrastructure.

John Burns Construction will be performing the axis point installation and the node installation for the Lighting Management System. The Lighting Management Systemincludes the complete design, installation, start-up, commissioning, operation, and maintenance of a networked lighting management system that enables, at a minimum, remote monitoring and control of outdoor lighting. The Lighting Management System will be able to capture remote monitoring and control of lighting, secure timely data transmission, obtain lighting asset inventory, energy usage data, provide mobile device applications, integrate with the City's 311 system, perform adaptive lighting, and integrate with the City's 911 system.

CTA RAVENSWOOD LOOP CONNECTOR SANDBLAST & PAINT






Preparation of the containment area and cleanup of the sandblasting for upcoming paint work

Chicago, II (Franklin St)

Spanning two construction seasons, the "Ravenswood Painting Project" is scheduled for Fall 2019 completion.

Released via CTA's Midcon Program, the \$2.1M Ravenswood Loop Connector Sandblast & Painting Project will revitalize approximately 1000 LF of elevated track structure. The JBCC/Atlantic Painting team is sandblasting and applying a high-performance coating to preserve the existing track structure. Located in Chicago's River North Neighborhood, JBCC has coordinated closely with local residents, businesses and the City of Chicago in an effort to minimize disruption. Substantial Completion is scheduled for September 24, 2019.








ISTHA TOLLWAY

Project 1819 includes rehabilitation and modernization of various portions of roadway lighting and Tollway ITS components on a 13 mile section of I-294 in the northwest suburbs. Roadway lighting rehabilitation work includes inspection of approximately 900 roadway lighting aluminum mast arms, removal and replacement of approximately 1,100 existing high pressure sodium roadway lighting luminaires and associated pole wiring with new LED fixtures, removal and replacement of 16 existing damaged light poles and foundations, installation of 7 new light poles to increase lighting on southbound I-294 near Touhy Avenue, and rehabilitation of 15 lighting controllers. ITS work includes replacement of 15 out dated CCTV cameras and associated communication gear along the I-294 corridor.

Mid 2019-To Date, JBCC provided our telecom and electrical ductbank construction services at several data centers in the Greater Chicago Metropolitan Area.

We've worked for several different customers on these data centers, and they have all been very pleased with our execution. Virtually all of them are offering repeat work at upcoming data centers.

All of these projects have been delivered on-time and under budget, so hats-off to the entire project team for their Love of the Game and "Customer First" execution.

Additionally, in May 2019 Illinois passed legislation which contained a package of business-friendly initiatives, and Chief among them are tax breaks for data centers, so we can expect many more opportunities at this type of work.




